- We have a dedicated security team and Stewards who will be patrolling throughout the Fayre – wearing Event Management tops. Please do let them know of any concerns, issues or incidents (including safe guarding)
- Advice and assistance is available from the Show Office located near the entrance of the Fayre. Lost property or missing children can be left / found there or contact a Steward.
- There is also a Meeting Point near to the TEA TENT.
- The First Aid station adjacent to the pedestrian entrance.
- Toilets are available throughout the site.
- Wristbands are available at the entrance tent so you can put your mobile number on them.
- To assist our security CCTV is in use.

The Fayre opens at 10.00 am and closes to the public at 23:45 pm.

*Please be aware that the Fayre is held on agricultural land, the ground may be uneven so take care.

- Please - NO GLASS – Animals graze in the field.
- There will be moving vehicles and working machinery, DO NOT cross safety barriers.
- Announcements may be made via the Public Address system or by Stewards. Please follow their instructions.
